This course focuses on providing a general overview of using and integrating technology into teaching. Participants look at how to incorporate aspects of technology into subject teaching to aid, enhance and motivate learners and the learning process. The course also aims to raise participants' awareness of the importance of using technology as a teaching tool in the modern classroom.

Delivered to classes of small groups by way of presentations, guided discovery and class activities. Subject specific lessons may also be delivered to closed groups
